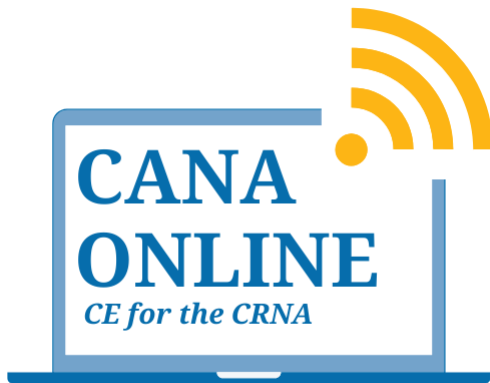

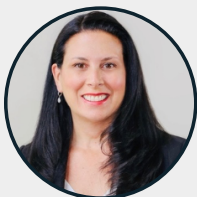
Emotional Intelligence in Healthcare and Implications for Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetists (CRNAs)

Lessons Learned at the Sharp End of Care. The Aftermath of Adverse Events: Our Voices are Finally Heard!

Most health care professional will experience an adverse event/near miss and/or patient death in the course of their career. Policies and procedures on how to handle the aftermath of these events and the emotional well-being of the health care professional have not been mandated. If a "business as usual" mentality is adopted, this may lead to dysfunctional behavior, subsequent harm to the health care professional and suboptimal care for subsequent patients.
